Objective:

To discuss New College's Master Plan and collaborate with students, faculty, and staff on ideas and suggestions for the Campus Master Plan (CMP).

Meeting Minutes:

David Rancourt, Vice President of Enrollment Management and Student Services, opened the meeting and discussed the importance of a master plan and how it is required for all state universities. The importance of this meeting is for our NCF community and the public to provide constructive ideas as the update to the Campus Master Plan is in development.

Richard Corcoran, President of New College, provided information about the master planning process and how feedback can be provided. He shared how the last Master Plan was completed in 2016. He also shared the three main focuses on campus including the student experience, transforming the east side of campus, and adding a world-class sports facilities. He recognized the individuals responsible for working on this project, naming Glenn Darling at Hall Darling Architects, Chris Reed from Stoss, Designlab, Marty Hylton, Architecture Sarasota, and Sweet Sparkman. He thanked everyone involved and turned over the meeting to Glenn Darling of Hall Darling Architects.

Hall Darling provided a high-level overview of the master planning, process, and timeline.
