



<b>Tuition</b>	Tuition is the basic fee charged for instruction provided by a public postsecondary educational institution in Florida. In some contexts matriculation is synonymous with tuition.
<b>Non-Resident Fee</b>	The non-resident fee is an additional fee charged to a student for instruction provided by a public postsecondary educational institution in Florida who does not qualify for in-state tuition pursuant to s.1009.21.
<b>Tuition Differential</b>	Tuitional differential is a supplemental fee charged for instruction provided by a public university in Florida pursuant to s.1009.24(15). This fee is used to support undergraduate educational programs and services.
<b>Financial Aid Fees</b>	The financial aid fees are set by the Florida State Legislature and not to exceed 5% of the resident tuition and non-resident fee. At least 75% of the revenue generated by these fees must be used to support need based financial aid.
<b>Capital Improvement Trust Fund</b>	The capital improvement trust fund fee exists to provided educational and support facilities for students, faculty and staff in a manner that maximizes the effectiveness of the capital investments, the use of existing facilities, and promotes orderly, planned campus development.
<b>Activities and Service Fee</b>	The student activities and service (A&S) fee supports activities and operations managed by the student government organization to improve services that benefit the general student body.
<b>Health Fee</b>	The health fee supports student health operations and provide access to the Counseling & Wellness Center (CWC) with many services offered at little or no direct cost to the student.
<b>Athletic Fee</b>	The athletic fee supports the university's athletic programs and enables students to attend athletic events with no direct cost to the student.
<b>Technology Fee</b>	The technology fee supports technology dedicated to academic programs.
<b>Green Fee</b>	The green fee was authorized by the Board of Trustees and the Board of Governors with the support of NCF Student Government to support various campus sustainability initiatives.
